Needs Analysis

Each partner organisation collected national data via interviews for case studies, focus groups and in a written survey via questionnaires, which formed the basis of this international needs of adults with migrant backgrounds on how to develop social entrepreneurship competences

Aim of Needs Analysis

The purpose of the needs analysis is to establish concrete data and a methodological framework on which to base the future intellectual outputs (IO) of this project including O1/OOC (Open Online Course for Social Entrepreneurship), IO 2 (Educational Content), as well as dissemination plans in order to ensure long term exploitation and sustainability of this project.



▶ CONCLUSION

It must be admitted that immigrants are one of the disadvantaged groups in the social structure of the country they migrate to. It seems paradoxical to expect immigrants, who are already experiencing economic and socio-cultural problems, to take a social initiative. The aim here is creating a proactive migrant initiative that does not expect the solution of their problems from others and finds their own solutions by increasing their awareness.

All the findings show that the data collected from 611 immigrants, including Turkey, Greece, Italy, and Poland, need a well-planned training in order to become entrepreneurs and social entrepreneurs in the country they migrated to and to participate in studies in this field.

Based on the findings obtained from the collected data, it is proposed to develop the skills of immigrants in the following areas in a training program designed to develop entrepreneurship and social entrepreneurship skills.

▶ Learning Teaching Training Activity Larissa, GREECE

A learning Teaching and Training Activity for 12 educators/facilitators will be held.

The event will be designed in a way that the participants will be put on a course to developing their own social venture as well as learning how to train adults with migrant backgrounds on social entrepreneurship. They will start as a beginner, getting introduced to basic concepts of social entrepreneurship. Once they complete the event, they will come out with an intricate understanding of the key elements of starting a social venture and the core foundations of social entrepreneurship.

▶ Multiplier Event TURKEY

A Multiplier Event will be held in Zonguldak, TURKEY. 100 national participants will get part. The aim of the event is to disseminate O1/OOC and O2/EC with. The event will also work as a Learning Teaching Training activity as there will be workshops on the idea of social entrepreneurship for adults with migrant backgrounds, with the contribution of keynote speakers and experts specialized on the topic.

Policy makers will be also invited because of the importance of the event. Target of the project (educators/teachers/facilitators) as well as the other stakeholders (Local and national Authorities, Public etc.) will be invited to the event.
